We offer government funded places for all 3 & 4 year olds for 15 hours per week. Places are funded from the term after your child's 3rd birthday. Terms start in September, January and April.

Parents working over 16 hours per week and earning under £100,000 per year can claim 30 hours of government funded childcare, starting from the term after your child turns 9 months of age. Parents need to apply for this funding, provide us with the funding code and reconfirm your funding entitlement every 3 months.

Funded places are also available for some 2 year olds for 15 hours per week, where parents are receiving certain financial support from the government. Parents also need to apply for a code for this funding.

The government website 'Best Start in Life' has full details of all funding criteria and entitlements, as well as information on tax free childcare which can also be used at Brightside Preschool. We direct you to this website to ensure you are given the correct information for your individual family circumstances. If you require further assistance, just let us know and we can look at the information together.

Brightside Preschool do not charge a registration fee in order to make our setting accessible to all families. Please note, parents are asked to contribute £1 per week to cover the cost of the snack which we provide.

Please ensure that you inform us as soon as possible if you no longer require your requested place. Once a child starts attending Brightside Preschool, we require half a term's notice (minimum 6 weeks) before leaving or reducing sessions. Sessions will be charged for during the notice period, even if your child does not attend. If you have financial difficulties at any time please let us know, we are here to help.
